

Indexes

CINAHL Plus with Full Text (online through EBSCOHost)

Contains the full texts for more than 560 journals dating back to 1937.

CINAHL Select (online through EBSCOHost)

Contains full-text (PDF) coverage of over 170 journals from 1973 to the present, updated weekly.

Cumulative Index to Nursing and Allied Health Literature (CINAHL) (available in print)

Covers magazine and journal articles from 1977 to the present.

Health and Wellness Resource Center (available online via Gale)

Covers magazines, journals, and newsletters 1980 to the present, newspapers 1999 to the present, and pamphlets (current year plus two years backfile). Includes an alternative health module.

Health Reference Center Academic (available online via InfoTrac)

Covers magazine and journal articles from 1980 to the present.

MedLine (available through EBSCOHost)

Covers journal articles from 1965 to the present.

New England Journal of Medicine (online)

Searchable full-text from 1993 to the present.

Pre-CINAHL (online through EBSCOHost)

Provides awareness of the newest journal articles (before they are indexed in CINAHL), with some full text.

For the Record. (print, past 2 years) Biweekly magazine for health information professionals.
