MVCC's Student Congress is sponsoring a voter registration drive September 15th, from 11 a.m.-2 p.m., in Room 116 of the Alumni College Center. They will be collecting voter registration forms, handing out free pizza and soda, and showing a film called "Everywhere But Florida." The film is described as an attempt to educate students on how the nation's election process works and inspire students to get involved in the 2004 national election.
