

## TENTATIVE REFUND DATES

If all requirements have been met, and all deferred expenses have been paid, (tuition, fees, books, dorms, meal plans), you may have a refund available. If you do, the Business Office will send you an e-mail alert with information needed to receive a check. If you do not receive an e-mail corresponding to the dates listed below, a check is not yet available to you. Please read the information carefully:

**Refunds should become available on the following dates:**

<b>Summer 2012</b>	<b>Friday, July 13<sup>th</sup> 2012</b>	(100% of available aid).
<b>Fall 2012</b>	<b>Friday, October 5<sup>th</sup></b>	<u>First</u> check is paid (50% of your federal aid and 100% of state aid "TAP" is paid).  Your attendance must be verified on or after Monday Oct. 1 <sup>st</sup> . Verification card is colored <b>green</b> .
	<b>Friday, October 26<sup>th</sup></b>	<u>Second</u> check is paid (100% of remaining aid).  Your attendance must be verified on or after Monday Oct. 22 <sup>nd</sup> . Verification card is colored <b>buff</b> (brownish).  <i>Census Date: 9/10/2012. Freeze point will be approximately one week after the census rosters are turned in.</i>
<b>Spring 2013</b>	<b>Friday, A UfW 8<sup>th</sup></b>	<u>First</u> check is paid (50% of your federal aid and 100% of state aid "TAP" is paid).  <b>Your attendance will be verified electronically.</b>
	<b>Thursday, 5df] 5<sup>th</sup></b>	<u>Second</u> check is paid (100% of remaining aid).  <b>Your attendance will be verified electronically.</b>  <i>Census Date: 2/11/13: Freeze point will be approximately one week after the census rosters are turned in.</i>
