### **Additional Notes**

### Minimum G.P.A. Requirement:

Students must have at least a 2.85 program GPA to be considered for selection.

### Selectivity Statement:

MVCC's nursing program is extremely competitive. Completion of necessary prerequisites does not guarantee admittance into the program. Students must respond to the Eligibility Assessment Survey which is emailed to all pre-nursing students each Fall and Spring semester. Students that reply and have completed the prerequisites are reviewed by a selection committee twice a year. A limited number of pre- nursing students are accepted into the program each fall.

### Transfer applicants:

In order to be considered for admission into the Nursing program, applicants must first be admitted to the College (refer to General Admission Requirements) and designate Associate Degree Nursing as their curriculum.

Admission testing, required developmental course work and indicated skills testing must be completed before applicants are eligible to enter the Nursing Program. Placement is pending availability.

#### LPN students:

A copy of their current license must be on file with the college before credit is granted for NU 101. All prerequisite requirements must be completed before students are eligible for registration or placement into nursing courses. LPN's are required to take the LPN Transition Course NU050 at MVCC when offered or the Excelsior College LPN to RN transition course.

Students may also opt to take Excelsior College Credit course # 559 for NU 102 and Excelsior # 503 for NU 103, in lieu of LPN Transition Course. Excelsior grades must be C or higher in order to receive transfer credit and students must pass MVCC skills test before placement into NU201. Completion of any Excelsior course(s) does not guarantee placement into MVCC nursing courses. Placement is pending availability.

### How this can be satisfied:

 An appropriate math placement test score (35 on the COMPASS Algebra section)

OR

- A grade of "C" or better in a MA 045 or MA 050 course
- A grade of "C" or better in a college level mathematics course

### **General Guidelines:**

- MA 045 or MA 050 must be completed within the last 3 years
- College-level math must be completed within 10 years before beginning the program
- Successful fulfillment is required before beginning chemistry



### How this can be satisfied:

- High School Chemistry with a lab with a final grade of 70 or higher OR
- A grade of "C" or better in the CH 091 and CH 092 course sequence
- A grade of "C" or better in a college level chemistry course

### **General Guidelines:**

- Must be completed within 10 years before starting the program
- Successful fulfillment is required before taking MVCC's Anatomy and Physiology course sequence





### How this can be satisfied:

- A grade of "C" or better in Human Anatomy and Physiology 1 (BI 106 OR
- A grade of "C" or better in a labbased, 4.5 credit-hour, college-level anatomy and physiology course

### **General Guidelines:**

- Anatomy and Physiology courses transferred in from other colleges will be weighted less in the selection process than those taken at MVCC
- Must be completed within 10 years before starting the program
- Students may repeat Anatomy and Physiology 1/BI 106, Anatomy and Physiology 2/BI107 and Microbiology/BI 201 course (s) one time at MVCC or any other college.
