(A)Core & GE Social Science (must choose at least one of the BOLD courses,) AN 101, GE 101, OS 101, PY 101, SO 101 CI 104, PS 202, PS 205, PY 101, PY 201, PY 202, PY 203, PY 204, PY 205, PY 206, PY 207, PY 208, PY 212, SO 202, SO 203, SO 204, SO 205, SO 206, or SS 218

(B) Core & GE Natural Science (must choose at least of the BOLD courses): BI 141, CH 141, GL 100, GL 101, PH 141 or PH 151, BI 142, CH 142, PH 152, PH 152

(C)Restricted Elective: Any course the student wishes to take except for BM 101

(D)Restricted Elective: Students must complete 2 courses from History/Civilization/The Arts: Choose two from the following: HI 111 or HI 112; AN 102, HI 101, GE 101, HU 227, HU 228, SO 208; EN 197, GC 244, HU 183, HU 184, HU 187, HU 188, SO 204, SO 205, SO 210, HU 292, PT 205, TH 193 or TH 195.

(1)The University at Albany does not accept transfer credit for College Foundations Seminar courses.

(2)This course is suggested because it meets a requirement for the major at UAlbany upon transfer.

(3)These courses must be taken at UAlbany unless completed elsewhere prior to matriculation.

(4)Economics electives must be at the 300-level or above, one of which must have a suffix of W taken at UAlbany.

A transfer student admitted to the University at Albany who has completed his/her A.A. or A.S. degree will be given credit for meeting SUNY's General Education requirements.

Transfer students who have not completed both A ECO 110 and 111, or their equivalents, with grades of C or better will not be formally admitted to the major when they enter the University. Transfer students who are not admitted, but who want to major in economics, may declare their intention to major in economics and will be advised by the department as intended majors for one semester. After satisfying the admission criteria, students may be admitted to the major.
