(A) Social Science Elective: AN 101, BM 101, GE 101, PS 101, PY 207

(1) The University at Albany does not accept transfer credit for College Foundations Seminar courses.

(2) Students from MVCC may transfer in a maximum of 12 credit hours for the Utica Fire Academy. They will be transferred in as 'Applied Elective Credits'. The College of Emergency Preparedness, Homeland Security and Cybersecurity will work with students to also evaluate the courses/trainings to count towards the Experiential Training requirement.

(3) This course meets the UAlbany 'Challenges of the 21st Century' requirement.

(4) Students must complete 100 hours of experiential training. Student must complete the minimum number of hours required in each training tier as follows: Foundations – 30 hours; Professional Development – 20 hours; Community Engagement – 15 hours; and Concentration Specific – 35 hours. Up to 40 hours of this training can be transferred in (5) Students must take 12 credits within one of the following Concentrations: Emergency Preparedness (BA), Homeland Security (BA), or Cybersecurity (BS). 6 credits must be lower level credits, and 6 credits must be upper level credits.

A transfer student admitted to the University at Albany who has completed his/her A.A. or A.S. degree will be given credit for meeting SUNY's General Education requirements.
