 (C)Foreign Language: Students must take 6 credits of the same language; FL, FR, GR, IT, or SP
 (D) General Education: Students can choose from any course from the MVCC General Education Course list not already in the curriculum
 (E) Core GE Natural Science: Students can choose from: BI 103, BI 105, BI 141, BI 216t, CH 101, CH 111, CH 120, CH 131, CH 141, GL 100, GL 101, GL 102, PH 106, PH 112, PH 141, PH 151, OH 261 or WE 101
 (F) Restricted Elective: Students need to take 3 classes (9 credits) of any 200-level course with a prefix of EN, HU, or HI or Foreign Language not already within the curriculum
 (G) Student can choose one of the following: SA 300m HU 280 or HU 295
 (1)The University at Albany does not accept transfer credit for College Foundations Seminar courses.
 (2)The upper division historical course must be selected from: A PHI 311, A PHI 314, A PHI 315, A PHI 321, A PHI 329, A PHI 342, A PHI 344, A PHI 346, A PHI 442, A PHI 523, A PHI 524, A PHI 544, A PHI 546, A PHI 550, A PHI 552, A PHI 554, or A PHI 556.
 (3)This course may be any course at the 400-level or above.
