- (A) GE Mathematics: Choose from MA 108, MA 110, or any higher course except MA 171 and MA 172 (based on placement test).
- (B) Foreign Language: Students must take 6 credits of the same language; FL, FR, GR, IT, or SP
- (C) General Education: Students can choose from any course from the MVCC General Education Course list not already in the curriculum
- (D) Core GE Natural Science: Students can choose from: BI 103, BI 105, BI 141, BI 216t, CH 101, CH 111, CH 120, CH 131, CH 141, GL 100, GL 101, GL 102, PH 106, PH 112, PH 141, PH 151, OH 261 or WE 101
- (E) Restricted Elective: Students need to take 3 classes (9 credits) of any 200-level course with a prefix of EN, HU, or HI or Foreign Language not already within the curriculum
- (F) Student can choose one of the following: SA 300m HU 280 or HU 295
- (1) The University at Albany does not accept transfer credit for College Foundations Seminar courses.
- (2) This course is suggested because it meets a requirement for the major at UAlbany upon transfer.
- (3) Select one of the following: APSY 380 or APSY 381.
- (4) Select one of the following: APSY 203, APSY 338, or TPSY 223.
- (5) Select one of the following: APSY 214, TPSY 214, APSY 382, or APSY 387.
- (6) Students must select any course offered with an APSY prefix. One course must have a T suffix. A maximum of 3 credits in independent study courses may be applied to major credit, but may not be used to meet the 300-level or above requirement.
- (7) APSY 210 and APSY 211 are restricted to A-E grading after matriculation at UAlbany.
- (8) Of the 36 credits required for the major, at least 12 credits must be in courses at the 300-level or above.

A transfer student admitted to the University at Albany who has completed his/her A.A. or A.S. degree will be given credit for meeting SUNY's General Education requirements. Transfer students who enter the University with 42 or more transfer credits, have transfer credit for APSY 101 and 210 with a grade of C- or higher in each, and have a 2.50 average for all psychology courses listed on the student's official degree audit that are applied toward the major will be conditionally admitted to psychology as a major and receive advisement in the psychology department. Such students must complete APSY 211 in their first semester here with a grade of C- or higher AND the student must have a grade point average of 2.50 or higher in Psychology courses listing as counting toward the major on their official degree audit upon completion of APSY 211 or their provisional admission to the major will be withdrawn. Transfer students who enter the University with 42 or more transfer credits, have transfer credit for APSY 101, APSY 210 and APSY 211 with a grade of C- or higher in each, and have a 2.50 average in all psychology courses listed on the student's official degree audit that are applied toward the major may immediately declare psychology as a major.
