(1) The University at Albany does not accept transfer credit for College Foundations Seminar courses.

(2) Students must complete 12 credits at or above the 300-level in one of the following concentrations or interdisciplinary concentrations: American Politics, Citizenship Equality and Inequality, Global Politics, Law and Institutions, Political Economy and Development, Political Theory, Public Law, or Security and Statecraft. Students must also take a 400-level writing intensive course that may be one of the courses within the concentration.

(3) Students must complete 15 Political Science elective credits. 6 credits must be at or above the 300-level, or among the 200-level that require a 100-level pre-requisite.

A transfer student admitted to the University at Albany who has completed his/her A.A. or A.S. degree will be given credit for meeting SUNY's General Education requirements.
