**This articulation agreement has been specially designed to fully accommodate graduates in A.A.S. degree programs.**

### **Purpose**

The purpose of this agreement is to facilitate credit transfer and provide a smooth transition for students in the A.A.S. Computer Information Systems degree program, at Mohawk Valley Community College into the B.T. Information Technology degree program at Morrisville State College.

### **Agreement**

This agreement applies to transfer students who have completed the A.A.S. Computer Information Systems degree program at Mohawk Valley Community College, received an Associate's degree, and meet admissions standards at Morrisville State College.

This agreement recognizes that the Associate's Degree program at Mohawk Valley Community College is consistent with the first two years of study at Morrisville State College and the combination of required coursework is in keeping with Morrisville State College transfer policies to grant full junior status.

Specific courses listed on the subsequent page are required to ensure proper alignment.

This Transfer Promise is our partnership with you in recognition of the high quality of your graduates. We pledge to provide an exceptional educational value by providing your students with the classes needed to complete a baccalaureate degree in four additional semesters. In addition, your graduates are eligible for a guaranteed preferred housing scholarship for four consecutive semesters.

### **Admissions Requirements**

Students transferring into Morrisville State College must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5 at the time of admission. Students must submit the SUNY Application as well as all college transcripts for review by the Morrisville State College Admissions Office. Students who have not yet graduated from Mohawk Valley Community College will also be required to submit high school transcripts.

### **Transfer Promise Program Requirements**

Students must be enrolled in four consecutive semesters, must maintain satisfactory academic standing, remain in good judicial standing, and successfully complete all classes in sequential order as advised.

### **College Graduation Requirements**

Please refer to the attached program guide sheet for requirements. Transferring students will be required to complete four consecutive semesters with a minimum of 60 credit hours of successful coursework at Morrisville State College, and meet College residency requirements. A minimum of 120 credit hours must be earned and a 2.0 minimum grade point average is required for graduation.

### **Articulation Implementation and Agreement Review**

Responsibility for oversight of this agreement rests with the Transfer Coordinator at Morrisville State College. One administrative or faculty member from each institution will be appointed to act as agents responsible for implementing this agreement; identifying and incorporating any changes into subsequent agreements; communicating changes to prospective faculty members, advisors, counselors, and others to whom the information is pertinent; and for conducting a periodic review of this agreement.

### **Additional Notes:**


This agreement becomes effective for academic year Fall 2015 and remains in effect until Fall 2018 unless terminated or amended by either party with prior written notice.
