- A.) GE Mathematics: Choose from MA 108, MA 110, or any higher course except for MA 171 & MA 172 (based on placement test); **SUNY Poly recommends MA 110.**
- B.) GE Social Science: Choose two courses from the following: AN 101, BM 101, GE 101, PS 101, PY 101, or SO 101 **POLY recommended taking both PY 101 & SO 101**
- C.) Foreign Language: Students must take 6 credits of the same language; FL, FR, GR, IT, or SP
- D.) General Education: Students can choose from any course from the MVCC General Education Course list not already in the curriculum. **SUNY Poly recommends students take one Psychology course (PY201, PY203, PY204, PY206, PY207, PY208) And one Sociology Course ( SO202, SO204, SO205, SO2060.**
- E.) Core GE Natural Science: Students can chose from: BI 103, BI 105, BI 141, BI 216t, CH 101, CH 111, CH 120, CH 131, CH 141, GL 100, GL 101, GL 102, PH 106, PH 112, PH 141, PH 151, OH 261 or WE 101
- F.) Restricted Elective: Students need to take 2 classes (6 credits) of any 200-level course with a prefix of EN, HU, or HI or Foreign Language not already within the curriculum.
- G.) Student can choose one of the following: SA 300, HU 280 or HU 295
