Intercultural Perspectives and Languages (6 credits)

BA majors are required to choose **2** courses of the same foreign language in a sequence from the following recommended courses: Arabic, Chinese, French, German, Italian, Japanese, Latin, Russian, Spanish. All 6 hours must be in the same foreign language (i.e. SPA 101, SPA 102).

BS majors can choose **2** of any of the above foreign language courses and/or the following recommended courses: EN255, EN256
