

Career Camp Proposal

Mohawk Valley Community College presents a very popular and exciting variety of youth enrichment programs during the February and April school breaks. These week-long, half-day “career camps” are targeted at students primarily in grades 4-9. Camps include both high-tech and non-technical topics. Past programs have included Sign Language, Arts and Crafts, Robotics, Archeology, Forensics, Lifeguarding and American Red Cross Babysitting.

We are looking for new ideas from people who can develop and teach 4-5 half-day, morning or afternoon programs in science, technology, culture, fine arts, history, outdoor skills, or other areas that would appeal to young people in grade ranges of 4-6 and 7-9. All programs focus on providing enriching, educational, fun experiences in a college setting.

Based on demand, each camp can be offered more than once and/or at both our Utica and Rome campuses. Camps are limited to 1 week for 4-5 half-days, from 9 a.m. – 12 p.m. or 1 - 4 p.m. (12-15 hours total). Camps run during the February (21-25) and April (18-22) school vacations.
