Previous meeting summary – Jill

COVID/Fall opening

- Lew proposed revisiting the (regional) positivity rate and possible reductions for in-person classes/academic unit density.
- Vaccinated individual who is exposed to a positive, you do not have to quarantine.
- Steph shared res. hall numbers and potential capacity and quarantine issues.
 - Explore tripling athletes (who will be vaccinated) in the triple rooms (that are now booked as doubles).
- Masking: Go back to ALL wearing masks inside (Vaccinated or not). Can be removed in designated eating areas and (optional) outdoors.
- Employee message will include re-instituting masks and an update to employees that vaccinations will be required for residence hall students. Will indicate additional message to be sent on Friday, 8/13.
 - Will identify a mitigation plan based on the regional positivity rate.

Testing: Unvaccinated individuals will be required to test weekly. Crystal will pursue the MOUs with the Collective Bargaining units.

Academic Plan: Discussed approach to maintaining (or reducing) in-person operations based on positivity rates. Reassess at mid-term to determine whether or not to bring folks back.
