SOS

- Developed by SUNY to assess students' satisfaction with their college experience
- 24 Community Colleges participated in 2016
- Had 8 "medium" colleges in this data comparison
- MVCC has participated in the survey since 1982, usually every three years

2016 SOS

- MVCC Survey was administered in classes on both campuses (not online or dual credit courses)
- 9 out of the 24 schools administered the survey online
- 607 surveys were used in the MVCC data
- Includes 14 MVCC specific questions

Highlights of MVCC Results

- MVCC means increased for many items, but so did other colleges - so rankings did not increase
- For MVCC 2016 means compared to MVCC 2013 means:
 - 59% increased,
 - 30% decreased,
 - 4% stayed the same, and
 - 7% were new questions

Highlights of MVCC Results

Compared to the other college results, MVCC students are:

- Younger
- More male
- Not as Hispanic
- Taking more ESL courses
- Not married or needing child care
- More often Dual Credit students
- More apt to be full-time students
- Enrolled in more on-campus courses (than online)
- Low income (receiving more Pell and TAP awards)
