Recognition and Wellness Councils Recommendations – David

- Recognition: create a local MVCC Excellence in Teaching award for CCED instructors. Would need to identify an additional \$500 in budget. All in agreement.
- Genesis Award nominations – reviewed last year's (unsuccessful) nominations and discussed direction for this year. Will move forward with one nomination (AIM program). Plan for C3 for next year (additional year of data will make a stronger nomination).
- Wellness Council:

 - Group fitness pilot (rotation of Zumba and yoga) over the lunch hour – encourage folks to try one, and support a flexible lunch hour (David will introduce at October administrators' meeting).
