Actions from last meeting - Jill

SUNY Updates

- Randy shared that the regional councils passed at last week's SUNY Board of Trustees meeting.
- There will be an all-Presidents' call today regarding Governor's proposed budget. Randy also reviewed what was included/excluded in the proposed budget.
- Tom – provided an update on capital projects. **Randy suggested the wayfinding project be presented to faculty caucus.**

Spring semester check-in – all

Student/employment rate of pay – Kim

- Reviewed guidelines and consistency for student employment pay rate. A clear definition should be established. **Kim will investigate further and return with more information at a future Cabinet meeting.**
