

Student Congress Minutes

March 1st, 2018

Jennifer called the meeting to order at 3:03 P.M.

Jennifer entertained a motion to approve last week's minutes. Kupr Kuprian motioned to approve the minutes from last week. Christal Deloach seconded the motion and the motion carries.
