 (4) Students must select two courses from the following: RPAD 304, RPAD 305, RPAD 324, RPAD/RRPS 343, RPAD 345, RPAD 354 or RPAD 438, RPAD/CEHC 445, RPAD/CEHC 449, RPAD/CEHC 457, RPAD 470, RPAD/CEHC 472, AECO 300, AECO 320, or AECO 355. The second course may also come from AECO 405, AECO 410, AMAT 214, AMAT 308, AMAT 382, AOGG 496, or CSI 203.  
 (5) Student must complete 18 credits in one concentration or 9 credits in two concentrations.
